

# **LORMA & CSPF PARTNERSHIP:** **PAMASKONG HANDOG KAY PASTOR PART 2**

SAN FERNANDO, LA UNION—Lorma Medical Center's Marketing Department, headed by Teresita Q. Klug, and the City of San Fernando Pastors' Fellowship, lead by its chairman, Rev. Brennus Paragas, once more partnered to sponsor an event benefiting the members of the City of San Fernando Pastors' Fellowship (CSPF).

*"Pamaskong Handog Kay Pastor Part 2"*, was launched to give member pastors free annual physical checkup, while Lorma Medical Center gave the discount for the annual PE. The leadership team of the CSPF, with the support of benevolent donors and benefactors, raised the necessary funding to make the annual PE at no cost to the pastors.

About 26 pastors, coming from various denominations, attended the launching of the *"Pamaskong Handog Kay Pastor"*, which was held at the Lorma Heliport Conference Room last December 16, 2010. Dr. Jan Paulette Sandrino, a Family Medicine physician of Lorma, made a brief presentation on the importance of papsmear and prostate specific antigen test.

The free annual PE is very unique from the usual gifts given to a pastor during the holiday season. According to Rev. Brennus Paragas, the Project will give pastors a chance to become aware of their health condition. He said that it is common to hear of pastors, who fail to sustain their ministry because of sickness or deteriorating health. Thus, the result of the physical check-up will guide them whether to take necessary rest or modify their lifestyle and ministry activities. Rev. Paragas also hopes that through this Project, congregations will be more supportive and concerned of the welfare and health of their respective pastors and ministers.
